The CreArt partner id11 has selected 8 artists for the next artist in Residence programme, that every year is organised in Delft in temporarily available spaces. For this edition, id11 collaborates with the multidisciplinary festival Car Art , where cars or car parts are, in its most literal or abstracted form, the source of inspiration. The artists will live during two months in the space Lijm & Cultuur and work in their projects until a final public presentation within the framework of the festival.

"WHITE NOISE, BLACK WORDS", SECOND CreArt EXHIBITION WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF 20 ARTISTS FROM THE CreArt NETWORK.

White Noise, Black Words is an exhibition that brings together 20 CreArt network artists from twelve European countries. It is presented consecutively in Vilnius, Zagreb, and Harghita County during 2014. In each venue, the display and the artists' site–specific contributions vary. The featured works put forward realistic depictions and dreamlike representations, rational positions and unconscious tensions, perceptible objects and ghostlike entities, primitive rituals and daily actions, conversational dynamics and intimate gestures. This eclecticism is suggested by the exhibition's title: Whereas "white noise" is commonly known as a combination of all the sounds in the human spectrum, "black words" refers to the less-visible elements of the social fabric
