THE Creart European exhibition 2014 WHITF NOISE **WORDS**" WILL BE OPEN ON OCTOBER IN THREE DIFFERENT GALLERIES OF MIERCUREA_CIUC COUNTY, (HARGHITA ROMANIA). EUROPEAN **EXHIBITION** PREVIOUSLY DISPLAYED IN VILNIUS (LITHUANIA) AND ZAGREB (CROATIA) DURING THIS SUMMER.

The CreArt European Exhibition White Noise Black Words will be open next Friday 3rd October in Miercurea-Ciuc (Harghita, Romania) after travelling during the last three months along Vilnius (Lithuania) and Zagreb (Croatia). The Exhibition will be presented in three different exhibition spaces along the city until 30 November: Harghita County Council's Art Gallery, Art Gallery from Kossuth Lajos street and Pál art Gallery. As it happens in previous occasiones, Opening will count on the presence of some of the selected artists, curators, and CreArt technicals.

According the words of the curators João Laia + Rosa Lleó with Miguel Amado the featured works are in an array of media: painting, sculpture, drawing, photography, installation, video, and sound. They offer up realistic depictions and dreamlike representations, rational positions and unconscious tensions, perceptible objects and ghostlike entities, primitive rituals and daily actions, conversational dynamics and intimate gestures. White Noise, Black Words investigates the fragile balance between abstraction and figuration, immateriality and concreteness, fact and symbol, existence and imagination. Whereas "white noise" is commonly known as a combination of all the sounds in the human spectrum, "black words" suggests less-visible elements of the social fabric.

These are some of the upcoming activities planned in the CreArt programme for the end of 2014 and 2015; In November next CreArt Conference will take place in the Must Museum of Lecce, to talk about new creative spaces in Europe; from December we will start to launch four new Open Calls to AiR programmes in Linz, Kaunas, Delft and Kristiansand, during 2015; in March we we will celebrate the 3rd Edition of the European Day of Artistic Creativity and a Encounter for artists and technicals in 2015; finally in summer we will open the 3rd Group European Exhibition that will travel to Pardubice, Linz and Genoa.



THE INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL OF VALLADOLID SEMINCI PRESENTS THE FILM "EL TALLER" PERFORMED WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF CreArt PROJECT

"EI taller", is the title of the film directed by Víctor Hugo Martín Caballero, which premiere will be at the 59th edition of the SEMINCI, that will be held from 18 to 25 October. The documentary (86") was performed in Valladolid in February 2013, when it took place a 5-days workshop leaded by the Spanish painters Antonio López and Cristóbal under the CreArt (Network of Cities for Artistic Creation) project. In this workshop, 25 artists from 9 countries, worked and reflected about the representation of the reality through painting. The documentary shows the development of those 5 days workshop, through their joint work, and their conversations.
