
The AiR CreArt project in Delft coordinated by Art Initiative id11 started last 5th August in the Kadmium Centre. This specific project refers to the Vermeer's painting View of Delft and encourage the artists to produce contemporary variants and site-specific works related to the location. Art initiative id11 have been organizing for some years artist-in-residence projects in temporarily available spaces such as vacant shops, office spaces or apartment buildings to be demolished or renovated. At the end of September there will be a final public presentation of the works produced by the 8 guest artists: Amaya Bombin (Valladolid-Spain), Alexander Glandien (Linz-Austria), Tvrtko Buric (Genoa-Italy), Bernadisiute Dovile (Vilnius-Lithuania), Lieke Snellen (Delft-The 3/4/2014 *|MC:SUBJECT|*

Netherlands), Leonard Sherifi (Genoa-Italy), Ruta Butkute (Kaunas-Lithuania), Nino Strohecker (Linz-Austria). On the other side, Patricia Sandonis and Julio Falagán (Valladolid-Spain), selected by the Centre Atelierhaus Salzamt in the past call, arrived recently to Austria to spend two months in this space dedicated to artistic residences run by the City of Linz and centrally located in the Danube.



"MORE REAL THAN THE REAL" CLOSED LAST 18th AUGUST WITH ALMOST 7.000 VISITORS IN VALLADOLID. FROM 5th OCTOBER THE EXHIBITION WILL BE HELD IN THE PALAZZO VERNAZZA CASTROMEDIANO OF LECCE (ITALY).

Last 18 August the First CreArt European Exhibition ended in Valladolid with a total number of 6.765 visitors and 746 participants (general groups, school children and different associations) in the activities planned under the educational programme.
